Deadline to file a nomination to run for Municipal Council

- The last day to file your nomination is **August 21, 2026, at 2:00 p.m.**
- Nominations must be filed with the Clerk before that time.
- The fee for nomination for Council is \$100; for Mayor is \$200
- The Clerk will certify the nominations on August 24, 2026, by 4:00 p.m. This means that the Clerk will determine if the candidate is eligible to run for office as per the legislation in the Municipal Elections Act.

Advanced Voting Days and Election Day

- The Council of the Town of Iroquois Falls enacted bylaw 3888/26 on May 25, 2026, which is a bylaw that provides for advance voting prior to election day, which occurs on October 26, 2026
- In the bylaw the following are the dates and times for advanced voting:

Voters List

- The deadline has now passed to verify online if you are on the voters list or to be added to the list online but do not worry....
- You can still contact or visit the Clerk at the Municipality as of September 1, 2026, to verify that you are on the list or to add, remove or change your personal information.

Proxy Voting

- Did you know that if you are unable to be present to vote on the Advanced Voting days or on Election Day, you are eligible to have someone function as a proxy for you to vote in the Municipal Election.
- If you are eligible to vote in the election and would like to vote by proxy, please message me for more information or contact the Municipality.

Municipal Voting

Did you know that a common misconception is that you must vote for the same number of candidates on the ballot to fill the required seats on Council. I have been asked this question several times in my discussions with Community members.

For Example, in the Town of Iroquois Falls, there is one Mayor and six Councillors elected to office. One would think that you must vote for one (1) candidate for mayor and six (6) candidates for Council.

In fact, you can vote for 0 or 1 candidate for Mayor and 0, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or up to six (6) candidates for Council. Your ballot will not be cancelled if you do not vote for the maximum positions available.

Example: If you believe that only three (3) candidates will represent our community best as Councillors then you can vote for just those three (3) candidates.
